Topic	Action
- Determine target populations. Primary goal is awareness/education. The committee agreed to focus on working age adults, particularly at worksites. Examples: Lincoln Industries does quarterly screens and mandates HRA; Hy-Vee provides an employee discount on insurance if a Diabetes Assessment and HRA is done.	
- Data from Workwell company survey of HRA results (10,000 surveys done) could be used to determine target goals.	Lisa to obtain permission to use aggregate data
- Number of community screenings to be increased to 1500 from 1000 targeted for last year	Diabetes Risk Assessments to be done/turned in for screenings completed at ActionNow! partner sites
- Objectives for achieving goals are identified on the 2008 Work Plan. Committee reviewed the action steps and outcomes. Revisions will be made as suggested.	
- Education/evaluation. Committee members requested available information on types/use of materials, impact of billboards, advertisement, etc.	Carol to obtain available data.
