<p>Objective 1: Promote awareness of risk to 1,500 adults through use of the Community Diabetes Risk Assessment.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hy-Vee and the Nebraska Dietetics Assn. will cover the cost of two tables at the KFOR Lifelong Living Festival on May 17th from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. at the Ag Hall building at State Fair Park. ActionNow! information will be on one of the tables and assessments will be offered. Members are welcome to come and help with assessments. • To date, 255 assessments have been received. • Discussed the use of incentives as a way to encourage people to fill out assessments. Members will check into company sponsorship to provide grocery gift cards or free gym visit/week as an example. • Members are encouraged to hand out a prescription sheet with each assessment. • Previous discussions regarding providing postage paid return envelopes and a mascot will not be pursued due to cost. • There will be a health fair for State employees on April 1st.
<p>Objective 2: Determine risk of diabetes through use of Worksite Health Risk Appraisal data.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WorkWell will work to access baseline data from health risk appraisal data in the next two months. The appraisal is free to all WorkWell members and at a minimal cost to members of the Wellness Councils of the Midlands and Well Workplace Nebraska.
